Your student is scheduled to take an Advanced Placement Exam in May 2024. Earlier this year, the students registered for their exams online at CollegeBoard.org via AP Classroom.


The fee for each exam is **\$98**, and we will again be accepting online payments for AP exams through MySchoolBucks.com. You will be receiving an email invoice directly from MySchoolBucks listing the AP course(s) your child will be taking and instructions on how to submit payment. There is **no extra fee** when submitting your payment online. However, should you wish to pay by check or money order, you are able to do so by completing and returning the attached registration form along with a check payable to **Lynbrook Public Schools**. Your child may bring payment to the Guidance office attention Sue Moller, AP Coordinator. Payment is due by Friday, February 9, 2024.

All students enrolled in an AP class are required to take the corresponding AP exam with the exception of the AP World History (Global History 10H) exam, which is optional. **If your student does NOT wish to take the AP World History exam, you must email Ms. Moller by Friday, February 9, 2024, to avoid the exam fee.** Note: In order to receive an "AP" designation on their transcript in Global History 10H, students *must* take the AP exam.

Students whose families face extreme financial difficulties and cannot afford these fees should request a fee waiver by writing or emailing Ms. Moller at susan.moller@lynbrookschoools.org by **December 22, 2023**.
