NEW QUARANTINE GUIDELINES:

Based on updated guidance from the NYS DOH, and in consultation with the district medical director, the district has revised its quarantine guidelines. The following requirements for quarantine will apply when a student or staff member is deemed a direct contact:

A) Quarantine can end after Day 10 without testing and if no symptoms have been reported during daily monitoring. Students/staff may return to school on Day 11.

B) Quarantine can end after Day 7 if a negative COVID-19 test result is reported and if no symptoms were reported during daily monitoring. A PCR test can be performed 48 hours before the time of planned quarantine discontinuation (Day 5), but quarantine cannot be discontinued earlier than Day 7. Students/staff may return to school on Day 8.
