Information to help guide your decision is as follows:

·Use of barriers will continue to be part of our protocols. ·Masks will be a continued requirement except when eating and during mask breaks. When masks are not worn, a distance of six feet must be maintained.

·Classroom layout will reflect the measurements presented by the Task Force 3 Committee. The students' desks will not be less than 4.5 feet front-to-back and 5 feet side-to side distance between students. Classroom instructional spaces may not take place in a typical classroom. Alternative spaces within the building will be utilized.

•GOLD students will retain their current classroom teacher. •It is possible daily schedules may change based upon survey responses for both GREEN and GOLD students.
