

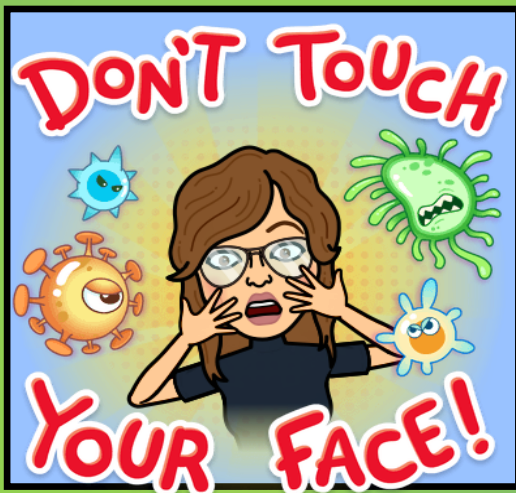

A survey for each student needs to be completed by Friday, March 12th.

Elementary Families:

Information to help guide your decision is as follows:

- Use of barriers will continue to be part of our protocols.
- Masks will be a continued requirement except when eating and during mask breaks. When masks are not worn, a distance of six feet must be maintained.
- Classroom layout will reflect the measurements presented by the Task Force 3 Committee. The students' desks will not be less than 4.5 feet front-to-back and 5 feet side-to-side distance between students. Classroom instructional spaces may not take place in a typical classroom. Alternative spaces within the building will be utilized.
- GOLD students will retain their current classroom teacher. • It is possible daily schedules may change based upon survey responses for both GREEN and GOLD students.
- If there is an overwhelming response to return, in-person learning may take place in a building that is not your home school.
