## Arrival Time Has Changed

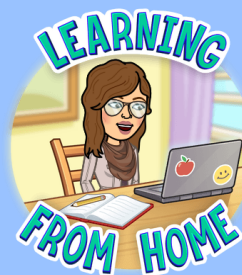
Our Elementary schools have transitioned into the new school year with refined arrival procedures. In an effort to increase instructional time for in-person learning during the elementary school day, the reopening task force has made the recommendation to shorten the morning drop-off window. Therefore, student arrival will be shortened to 15 minutes each morning. All students are expected to arrive between 8:30 am and 8:45 am, unless attending scheduled early morning extra help. The change in arrival times will begin on Monday, November 30th.
