### Food Program:

Pursuant to the Families First Coronavirus Response Act of 2020, the district has been encouraged by New York State to continue to offer free meals to children through Dec. 31, 2020. Accordingly, all meals served during the day at North Middle School, South Middle School and Lynbrook High School will be free of charge for all children. In addition, a free snack will also be served during the day at these locations. To accommodate the needs of our elementary, remote and hybrid students on days when they do not report to school, the district will be operating two after-school serving sites at North Middle School and South Middle School from 3-3:30 p.m. every day. A lunch and snack will be available for all children under the age of 18 at these sites. Service at North will take place at the side door by the parking field. Service will take place at South at the front door. Elementary and all remote students are entitled to a free lunch and a snack every day. Hybrid students are entitled to take a lunch and a snack at the end of the day for the next day when the student will not be present in school.
