KEEPING LHS, AND ALL OF OUR SCHOOLS, OPEN

Over the past two weeks 129 students at the high school were notified that they needed to quarantine for two weeks. That large number takes into account all students who were within 6 feet of one of the only 14 students who tested positive for the virus during that time.

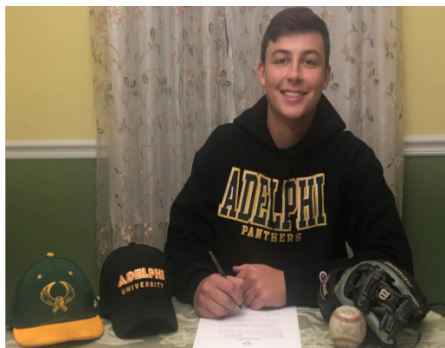
This month the Seiderman Virtual Gallery features the work of the students in Mrs. Karen Goulet's Clothing Design classes.

STUDENT LUNCH AND MEAL INFORMATION

As you may know our school district will offer free meals to children through June 30, 2021.

All meals served during the day at LHS are free of charge for all children. In addition, a free snack is available each day. To accommodate the needs of remote and hybrid students on days when they do not report to school, the district will be operating two after-school serving sites at North Middle School and South Middle School from 3-3:30 p.m. every day. A lunch and snack will be available for all children under the age of 18 at these sites.

Service at North will take place at the side door by the parking field. Service will take place at South at the front door. Remote students are entitled to a free lunch and a snack every day. Hybrid students are entitled to take a lunch and a snack at the end of the day for the next day when the student will not be present in school.
