It has been a tradition for the Marion Street School Band to participate in the Village of Lynbrook Memorial Day Parade. This year the parade will take place on Monday, May 26, 2025. Kindly follow these instructions:

- Band members are to meet at Jefferson Ave. and Charles Street, one block behind McDonald's **PROMPTLY** at 9:15 am.
- At the end of the parade, you are to pick up your child on the sidewalk in front of Temple Am Echad (Temple Emanu-El, Columbus Drive) which is directly across the street from Astoria Federal Bank. **NO BUS TRANSPORTATION TO OR FROM THE PARADE.**
- Please cooperate by having your band member present on time and in proper uniform: **MARION STREET MUSIC POLO. (NO VEST) DARK PANTS, DARK SOCKS, DARK SHOES. POLOS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED ONCE PERMISSION SLIP IS RECEIVED.**
- The parade begins at approximately **9:30 am.** Details to follow.

Starting place is by McDonald's; down Merrick Road making a left onto Forest Ave.; Forest Ave. making a right onto Stauderman Ave.; Stauderman Ave. making a right onto Atlantic Ave. (Business District); left back onto Merrick Rd. The parade ends by Lynbrook Village Hall.

Please remember that the Marion Street School Band represents our school community at this event. Appropriate behavior throughout the duration of the parade is of utmost importance.

We hope that as many band members as possible will be able to march in the parade. We look forward to participating in this wonderful tradition on this national day of commemoration.
